Saturday and Sunday, August 18-19. Men and women at least 50 years old are eligible. You must have a verifiable handicap to participate. The format will be 36 holes of stroke play with handicap. We will also have a super senior division for those ages 70 and older. There will be no default winners in any division, so there must be more than one competitor. Please sign up by Thursday at 5 p.m.

The **Men's and Women's Club Championships** will be Saturday and Sunday, August 25-26. Men wishing to compete in the championship flight must play a qualifying round by Friday, August 24, at 2 p.m. Qualifying and championship flight matches will be off the blue tees. Matches in the other flights will be handicapped and play will be off the white tees. The women's championship flight will require qualifying only if more than four women sign up. As in the men's competition, the women's championship will also have handicapped flights.

Patriot Golf Days will be Friday through Monday of Labor Day weekend. You are invited to make a donation of \$1 or more to benefit the Fold of Honor Foundation, which provides educational scholarships for children and spouses of military servicemen and women killed or disabled while serving our country.

Also on **Labor Day** weekend, we will have our holiday **scramble** at 9 a.m. on Sunday, Sept. 7. The scramble will be a combination of competitive and non-competitive. A portion of the entry fee will be set aside for a drawing; the other portion will be used to award prizes in the following divisions (based on number of entries): gross, net mixed, net men's. Divisions will be flighted if we have enough entries. The cost is \$55 for members with cart fee, \$45 for members without cart fee and \$65 for guests. The entry includes all golf fees, prizes and the after-golf barbecue-style lunch.

Range Rules –

Please RETURN range bags after using the practice area and before playing golf. Signature members, please note that the range balls are included with your membership for your use only, not to share with members who chose to join at the General, House or Associate level. They must purchase range balls at the pro shop or join the seasonal range plan (\$200 for the season).

Rules to Remember:

*Our dress code *prohibits jeans and sweat pants* on the golf course and practice areas, *including the range*. Also, men must have shirts with collars or T-necks. Women's shirts must have collars or sleeves.

Alcohol - ALL alcoholic beverages on the course MUST be purchased at the Clubhouse. You are not permitted to bring your own alcoholic beverages onto the golf course.

*Be sure to know the cart rules for the day. "Cart Path Only" means just that -- carts must stay on the paths. "Carts 90 Degrees" means you must stay on the path until you are directly across from your ball. You may then drive from the path directly to your ball and back to the path.
Carts must stay on the paths around tees and greens.
