## **2012 Instruction Programs**

### **JUNIOR CLINICS** (Sundays, June 24 through August 5)

Cost: \$10 per week

1:00 p.m. – Juniors (ages 9-12) – half-hour of instruction

1:30 p.m. -- Young Duffers (up to age 10) – utilizing the SNAG program

2:15 p.m. – Teens (ages 13-17) – half-hour of instruction

### **WOMEN'S CLINICS** (Saturdays, June 23 through August 11; no clinic on July 21)

Cost: \$20 per week

Time: 11 a.m. to noon

Designed for the novice to intermediate golfer, focusing on a difference aspect of the game each week.

### **GET GOLF READY** (Saturdays, June 23, June 30, July 7)

Cost: \$99 for six hours of instruction 1:00 to 3:00 p.m.

All Pinecrest residents and their guests are welcome. This is a beginner program that will utilize the SNAG system and transition to real golf equipment. The goal is to get you ready to play golf in three sessions. Limited to 8 people (minimum of 3 required to hold program). We'll add more sessions and/or instructors if demand warrants. Payment required at the time of registration.

### **Rules to Remember:**

\*Our dress code *prohibits jeans and sweat pants* on the golf course and practice areas, *including the range*. Also, men must have shirts with collars or T-necks. Women's shirts must have collars or sleeves.

Alcohol - ALL alcoholic beverages on the course MUST be purchased at the Clubhouse. You are not permitted to bring your own alcoholic beverages onto the golf course. Beer will be available for sale in the Pro Shop and is also available in the Clubhouse bar.

\*Be sure to know the cart rules for the day. "Cart Path Only" means just that -- carts must stay on the paths. "Carts 90 Degrees" means you must stay on the path until you are directly across from your ball. You may then drive from the path directly to your ball and back to the path.  
**Carts must stay on the paths around tees and greens.**

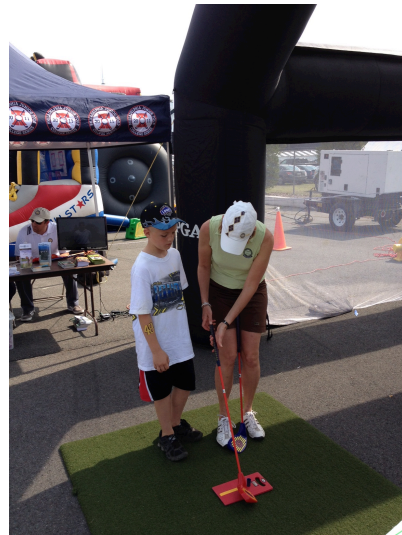
